# Directions

# BY CAR:

## From I-80, I-55, and the Southwest including the downtown:

Take the exit for I-55 North into downtown Chicago. Take the Lake Shore Drive exit; continue on Lake Shore Drive going north until you reach Sheridan Road where Lake Shore Drive ends. Turn right onto Sheridan Road. Turn left onto West Granville Road and turn right on North Kenmore Road. The Simpson Lot entrance is located on the left just before Sheridan Road.

#### From I-88 and the West:

Take I-88 East to Chicago. Take the exit for I-294 West north to Wisconsin. Take the exit for I-90 East to Chicago. Take I-90 east to the Lawrence Avenue Exit. Take a left on Lawrence going east until you reach Sheridan Road. Turn left onto West Granville Road and turn right on North Kenmore Road. The Simpson Lot entrance is located on the left just before Sheridan Road.

#### From I-94 and the North:

Take I-94 East south to Chicago. Take the exit for Touhy Avenue East. To stay on Touhy, bear right once you cross Ridge Road, continue on Touhy Avenue until you reach Sheridan Road. Take a right on Sheridan Road. Continue on Sheridan Road past the Devon/Broadway/Sheridan intersection and continue straight on North Broadway Street one traffic light to West Rosemont Ave — turn left. Turn left again onto Kenmore Avenue. The Simpson Lot entrance is located on the left just before Sheridan Road.

### Parking

Unless you arranged parking with us in advance you will need to either find street parking or park in lot P3 (see map). Parking in P3 is \$7 per day. Free street parking is frequently available on North Wintrope or North Kenmore in the first several blocks south of West Sheridan. There are also usually metered spots south of campus on West Granville. Regardless make your way to the intersection of West Sheridan and North Kenmore and then follow the instructions on the next page.

#### BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

#### The "L" from the South:

Purchase a CTA transit card (\$2.25 per ride) at the kiosks before boarding. Take the Red Line and look for the signs indicating "Northbound to Howard," and take the train to the Loyola stop. Exit the train station through the metal turnstiles and to your left you will see a bus stop in front of the McDonald's. Take CTA bus # 147.

#### The "L" from Evanston or Skokie and the North:


Purchase a CTA transit card (\$2.25 per ride) at the kiosks before boarding. Take the Purple or Yellow Line to Howard station. Then look for the signs indicating "Southbound to 95th/Ryan" on the Red Line. Take the train to the Loyola stop. Exit the train station through the metal turnstiles and to your left you will see a bus stop in front of the McDonald's. Take CTA bus # 147. Exit at North Kenmore Avenue and follow walking instructions below.

### CTA Bus:

Purchase a CTA Transit card for the value of \$5.50 (that is the value of 2 rides to come to Loyola and return home). From south/Downtown, take CTA bus # 147 (Outer Drive Express) towards Howard Station. From the north, take CTA bus # 147 (Outer Drive Express) towards Congress Plaza. Exit at North Kenmore Avenue and follow walking instructions below.

# Walking to Coffey Hall from CTA 147 Bus Stop:

1. Walk east on the north-side of Sheridan Rd., passing Mundelein Center on your left (see picture below).



3. Walk through the courtyard and pass through a small passage to your left between the 2 buildings.



2. Then you will see a courtyard with flowers and a fountain on your left.



4. Follow the path and turn towards the right. You will then see a sign that says:

Coffey Hall Faculty Offices Entrance 1000 W. Sheridan



5. Walk into the building and either go down the halfflight of stairs to your left or take the elevator down to LL. The CANIab reception (LL21) is straight ahead.
